Please purchase only supplies listed. Individual teachers may require additional supplies.

Kindergarten

- * *label items with student's name*
- * Backpack—one that is easily managed by your child but large enough to hold 9 x 12 paper, no wheels
- 12 – 15 small glue sticks (Elmer's brand works best)
- * 1 plastic 5" x 8" school box –no larger
- 3 boxes of 16 or 24 count crayons (Crayola brand works best) Tape the bottoms of the boxes closed
- * 2 PRIMARY composition notebooks
- * 1 bottom-pocket folder
- * 1 pair Fiskar-type scissors
- 1 large eraser
- \$5 for special projects—checks to "Orchard Heights" with "Kindergarten" on memo line
- Girls: 1 roll paper towels, 1 box baby wipes OR 1 pack sanitizer wipes
- Boys: 1 large box of tissues, 1 box of washable markers OR 1 box colored pencils
